MusicRow Magazine 2015 Next Big Thing artist, **Maddie & Tae**, premiered a taste of the official music video for the sophomore single, "Fly," with the release of a photo. Only the third female duo in over 70 years to have a No. 1 with their first single, they brought their second single to the *The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon* last Friday (Jan. 23). Top Ten— Chris Young isn't lonely at the top of the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart. I'm sure he is very content with "Lonely Eyes" reaching No. 1. **Lee Brice** brings his "Drinking Class" up one spot to No. 2. **Blake Shelton's** "Lonely Tonight" is not a sequel to Young's chart topper, it's his own that is now at No. 3. **Jake Owen** is going to spend another week at No. 4 with "What We Ain't Got" followed by **Lady Antebellum's** "Freestyle" at No. 5. **Dierks Bentley** gains one spot and is at No. 6 with "Say You Do." **Tyler Farr** is also one step closer to the top with "A Guy Walks Into A Bar" landing at No. 7. **Jason Aldean** still has momentum with "Just Gettin' Started" moving up to No. 8. **RaeLynn** is in the Top 10 this week with "God Made Girls" breaking in at No. 9. **Easton Corbin** is also new to the Top 10 with "Baby Be My Love Song" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— When two country superstars collaborate on a song, it usually means big gains in spins. This is true again for **Keith Urban** and **Eric Church**, with their song "Raise 'Em Up" gaining 641 new plays. **Zac Brown Band** is getting a nice response to "Homegrown." It is up 529 spins this week. Radio listeners are loving **A Thousand Horses'** "Smoke," which gained 398 more times than last week. **Tim McGraw's** "Diamond Rings And Old Barstools" is up 322 spins and **Kenny Chesney's** "Wild Child" is up 243.

Debuts— Kenny Chesney is our lone debut this week. His collaboration with **Grace Potter** on the song "Wild Child" makes the chart for the first time this week at No. 72.

Voices Of Secondary Radio

Chris Young has climbed back to the top of the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart. After 23 weeks of working its way up, "Lonely Eyes" is this week's No. 1 song.



The third single, released from his fourth studio album, *A.M.*, will receive Young his second *MusicRow* Challenge Coin in addition to songwriters **Johnny Bulford, Jason Matthews** and **Laura Veltz**. His first single from the album *Who I Am With You* was our top song back in June of 2014.

"Lonely Eyes" has sold close to 200,000 digital sales. The music video was released late last year and can be viewed [here](#).

In his August 2014 [weekly DISclaimer](#), **Robert K. Oermann** said, "Chris turns the charm meter up to 10 on this throbbing roadhouse romance. He also sings his fanny off."

Young is on a [co-headlining tour](#) with **Lee Brice** through March 8. He will be making his third trip overseas as he plans to showcase [2015 A.M. World Tour](#) to international fans. This tour will begin in Australia on March 11 and will continue the tour in September with dates in England, Germany, and Sweden.

How long have you been at the station?

18 Years

How many "hats" do you wear every day?

I do the morning show, I'm the PD and MD. We're a small staff but a well-oiled machine.

What is your philosophy on adding new music?

Adding emerging artists is very important. The Garth's, Taylor's, Aldean's, FGL's were new once upon a time. You just never know. A good song is a good song regardless of label or promotional backing.

What role do promoters play in your music decisions?

It's all about communication and relationships. Hand in Hand.

Why is it important to report to MusicRow?

It gives us some "cred" in the Country Music Capitol of the World. *MusicRow* helps out the secondary markets like us.

Tell us something great about your station and/or city. (Feel free to brag!)

We are five miles from the Fort Drum Army Base, home of the 10th Mountain Division. (They yanked Saddam Hussein from his underground bunker.) The inventors/founders of the lifesaver, Dewey Decimal System, Arbor Day, bowling pins, and creme cheese are all from here.

Who are some NEW artists that you are excited about?

Erica Nicole, Granger Smith, Bobby Wills, and several more. The format is in great shape if you just give some independents a chance.
