Performers Announced For ACM Awards

The Academy of Country Music and dick clark productions have announced another round of performers for the 50th Academy of Country Music Awards. **Alan Jackson, Martina McBride, Brad Paisley, Lady Antebellum, Little Big Town, Rascal Flatts**, plus special duets by **Christina Aguilera** with surprise artists, as well as **Nick Jonas** with **Dan + Shay** have all been added to this year's incredible lineup. Top Ten— **Easton Corbin's** "Baby Be My Love Song" is now the No. 1 song after 28 weeks on the chart. **Billy Currington** moves to the No. 2 spot with "Don't It." **Sam Hunt** isn't taking his time getting to the top, as "Take Your Time" moves two spots to No. 3. **Eric Paslay's** "She Don't Love You" remains at No. 4 another week. **Miranda Lambert** rolls up two spots to No. 5 with "Little Red Wagon." **A Thousand Horses** gallops to No. 6 with "Smoke" and **Tim McGraw** moves up two spots to No. 7 with "Diamond Rings and Old Barstools." **Kenny Chesney** breaks the Top 10 and puts "Wild Child" at No. 8 followed by **Josh Turner's** "Lay Low" at No. 9. **Kelsea Ballerini** is also new to the Top 10 as she lands "Love Me Like You Mean It" at No. 10.

Greatest Gainers— **Blake Shelton** had the biggest gain with "Sangria" receiving 460 new spins. **Jason Aldean** moves "Tonight Looks Good On You" to No. 40 after 405 additional plays. **Lady Antebellum** saw "Long Stretch Of Love" land at No. 42 with 316 more plays this week. **Florida Georgia Line** received 282 new spins for "Sippin' On Fire," and **Michael Ray** was up to No. 41 thanks to 259 more plays for "Kiss You In The Morning." **Cam** moved up 19 spots after "My Mistake" received 252 additional spins.

Debuts— **Blake Shelton** also had the highest debut with "Sangria" landing at No. 47. **Brothers Osborne** land "Stay A Little Longer" at No. 71 followed by **Montgomery Gentry's** "Folks Like Us" at No. 72 and **Callie Twisselman's** "Breathe" at No. 73. Also making their first appearance on the chart are **Chase Likens** at No. 77 with "Playing It Safe," **Macy Martin's** "Back To Reality" at No. 78 and **New Black Seven** at No. 80 with "Fine Wine."

Nine North And Turnpike Music Adds Seiple

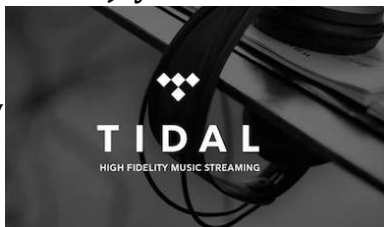

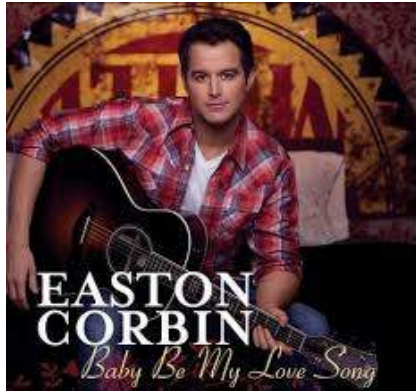

NO. 1 SONG

Easton Corbin's "Baby Be My Love Song" is at the top of the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart for Week 13 of 2015.



It took 28 weeks to arrive, but country radio is clearly loving Corbin's traditional sound in this, the second single from his upcoming album.

Set to be released next month, Corbin says the **Jimmy Collins** and **Brett James** single was one of the first he recorded. "I think it's a very fresh sound, but it's still country, right down the middle," he says.

Lee Richey/PD-MD/WKPQ/Hornell, N.Y.

How long have you been at the station?
three years at WKPQ.

How many "hats" do you wear every day?
I host our afternoon drive plus a lunchtime all request show. There's programming, adding music, creating logs, developing promotions, writing and producing commercials, and staying on top of our social media. And, I voice track a daily show for one of our sister stations in Corning, NY.



What is your philosophy on adding new music? Good production, catchy song, and the singer in tune is a must. I try to listen to everything that comes across my desk. If it grabs my attention right away, that's a big plus. We love station visits as well!

Why is it important to report to MusicRow? I believe *MusicRow* sets the tone, and accurately reflects the state of what's REALLY going on in country music. I think you see the trends and artists of tomorrow in *MusicRow* long before anywhere else.

Tell us something great about your station and/or city. WKPQ studios sit right on Main street of Hornell, N.Y. Having big glass windows at sidewalk level, we are very connected to our audience as they walk and drive by. Actor Bill Pullman is from Hornell so it's not uncommon to see Bill around town.

Who are some NEW artists that you're excited about? Clare Dunn, Cadillac Three, Rachel Holder, Kayla Adams, Gator Park.
