Top Ten— **Brad Paisley** has reached the No. 1 spot this week with "Perfect Storm." **Tim McGraw** moves up one spot with "Shotgun Rider" landing at No. 2 followed by a very quick moving **Carrie Underwood**. "Something In The Water" is now at No. 3. **Kenny Chesney's** "Til It's Gone" is up four spot to No. 5 and **Eric Church** is up one to No. 5 with "Talladega." **Darius Rucker** moves to No. 6 with "Homegrown Honey." New to the Top 10 this week are **Jake Owen** at No. 7 with "What We Ain't Got," **Thomas Rhett's** "Make Me Wanna" at No. 8 and **Lee Brice's** "Drinking Class" at No. 9. Last week's No. 1, **Maddie & Tae**, are at No. 10 with "Girl In A Country Song."

Greatest Gainers—**Luke Bryan** was the big gainer this week with "I See You" up 661 spins. **Blake Shelton** had a huge first week that saw 467 spins for "Lonely Tonight." **Jason Aldean** was up 457 plays for "Just Gettin' Started." **Brad Paisley's** "Perfect Storm" hit No. 1 thanks to 375 new spins. **Kenny Chesney** moves closer to the top with "Til It's Gone" gaining 328 additional plays.

Debuts— **Blake Shelton** had the highest debut with "Lonely Tonight" debuting at No. 56. **Brantley Gilbert** is on with "One Hell Of An Amen" at No. 66 and **Dustin Lynch's** "Hell Of A Night" at No. 68. **Chase Rice** made the chart with "Gonna Wanna Tonight" at No. 75. Also debuting this week are **Billy Ray Cyrus** at No. 76 with "Like A Country Song," Aaron Watson's "That Look" at No. 77, **Ricky Skaggs w/ Sharon White** at No. 78 with "Forever's Not Enough," **Frank Ortega's** "My Old Man" at No. 79 and **Shane Gamble** at No. 80 with "Beautiful Work."

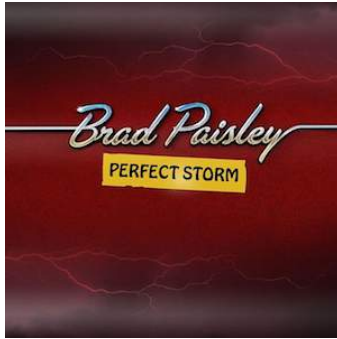

The women wanted to hear it and men wanted to say it, but **Brad Paisley** put in a song and now "Perfect Storm" is No. 1 on the *MusicRow* CountryBreakout Chart.

Robert Oermann's [DISCLAIMER review](#) of "Perfect Storm" praised Paisley as he "continues to dazzle as a player."

Co-written by both Paisley and **Lee Thomas Miller**, "Perfect Storm" is the second release off Paisley's 10th studio album *Moonshine In The Trunk*. The album title could have been the inspiration behind the [new clothing line called Moonshine Spirit](#) that Brad has released to Boot Barn.

Before heading up to [Canada for a few dates](#) to end the year, Paisley co-hosted the CMA Awards with **Carrie Underwood** for the 7th year in a row and certainly caused some discussion on a few of his jokes. But all of that was overshadowed by his mesmerizing performance of "Perfect Storm" on the show. Brad will be on TV again on Dec. 1 as a part of the CMA Country Christmas special to air on ABC. We're told that Brad and Rock Legend **Steven Tyler** will light up the stage in a rocking Christmas duet. We are in the spirit already!



How many "hats" do you wear each day?

I enjoy doing Mornings on KRG-Grand Island, NE. I also have on-air shifts on our Classic Country and Classic Rock stations. I Program the music on our 5 Country Stations. I prepare promotions, and I do play-by-play sports casting for our local High School.

What is your philosophy on adding new music?

It either sounds good on-air or it doesn't. Major label support or independent status doesn't reflect my decision on whether to add or not to add a song.

Why is it important for you to report to MusicRow?

Any radio station can play the top 40 songs and call it a day, but they're no better than the Jukebox at the local honky-tonk. We're the one's in the battle making the decisions that decipher why a song is even popular.

Tell us something GREAT about your station and/or city? (Feel free to BRAG!)

Grand Island host's the Nebraska State Fair and KRG-Grand Island, NE is the Flagship station in this Metropolitan area of around 50k people and over 100k people in the Tri-City area. KRG-Grand Island, NE was the first FM station in the market over 35 years ago.

Who are some new artists that excite you?

Chris Lane, Eric Paslay and one more artist that YOU NEED to play is Granger Smith. The Guy has a cult following and the songs are great and worth your time.
