



SMACKSongs and Worktape Music have partnered to sign **McCoy Moore** to a worldwide publishing deal.

The Lakeland, Florida native moved to Nashville after graduating from high school to pursue songwriting. Moore spent his first few years in town playing as many writers' rounds as possible, sharing original music and releasing songs independently as an artist. 
